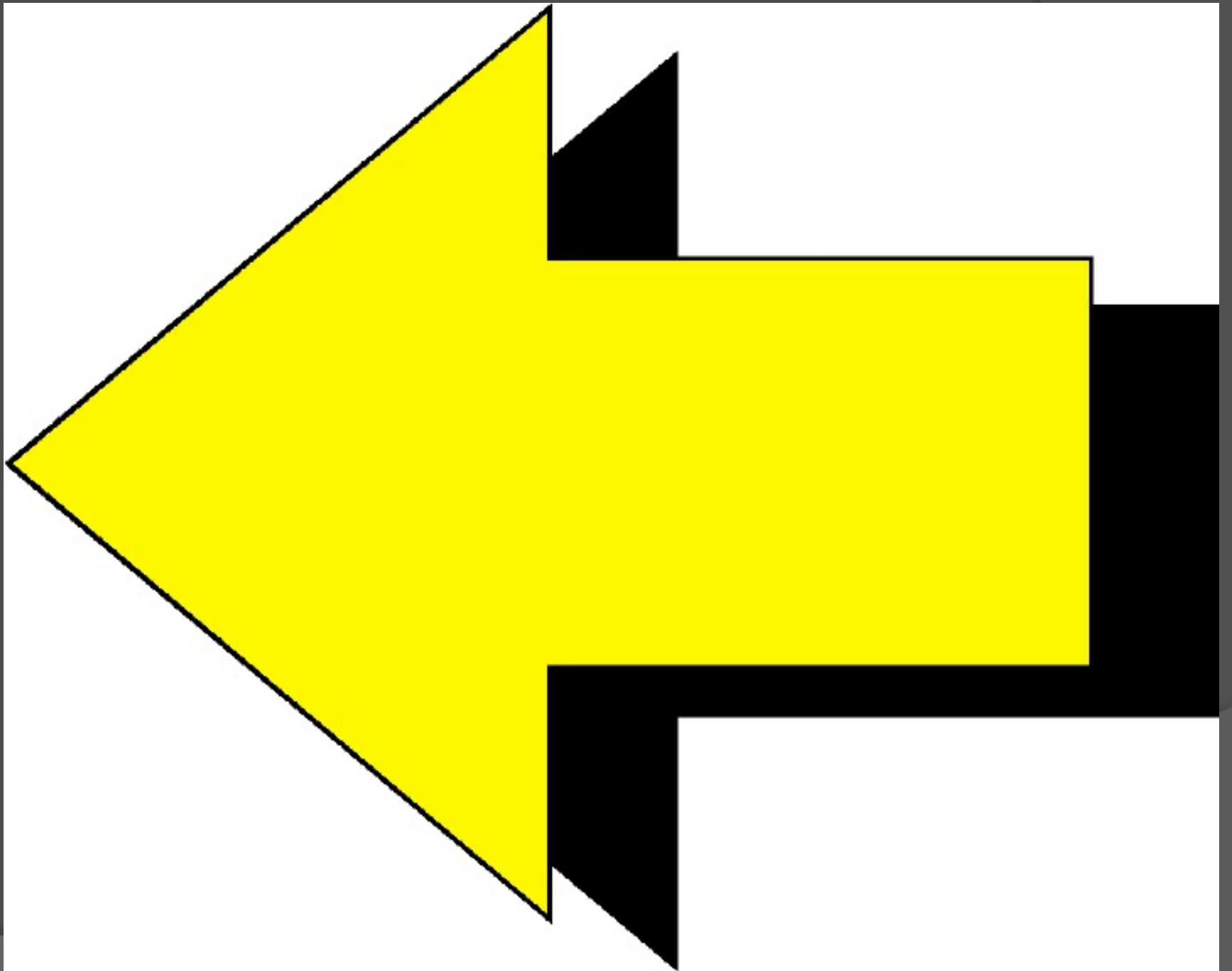

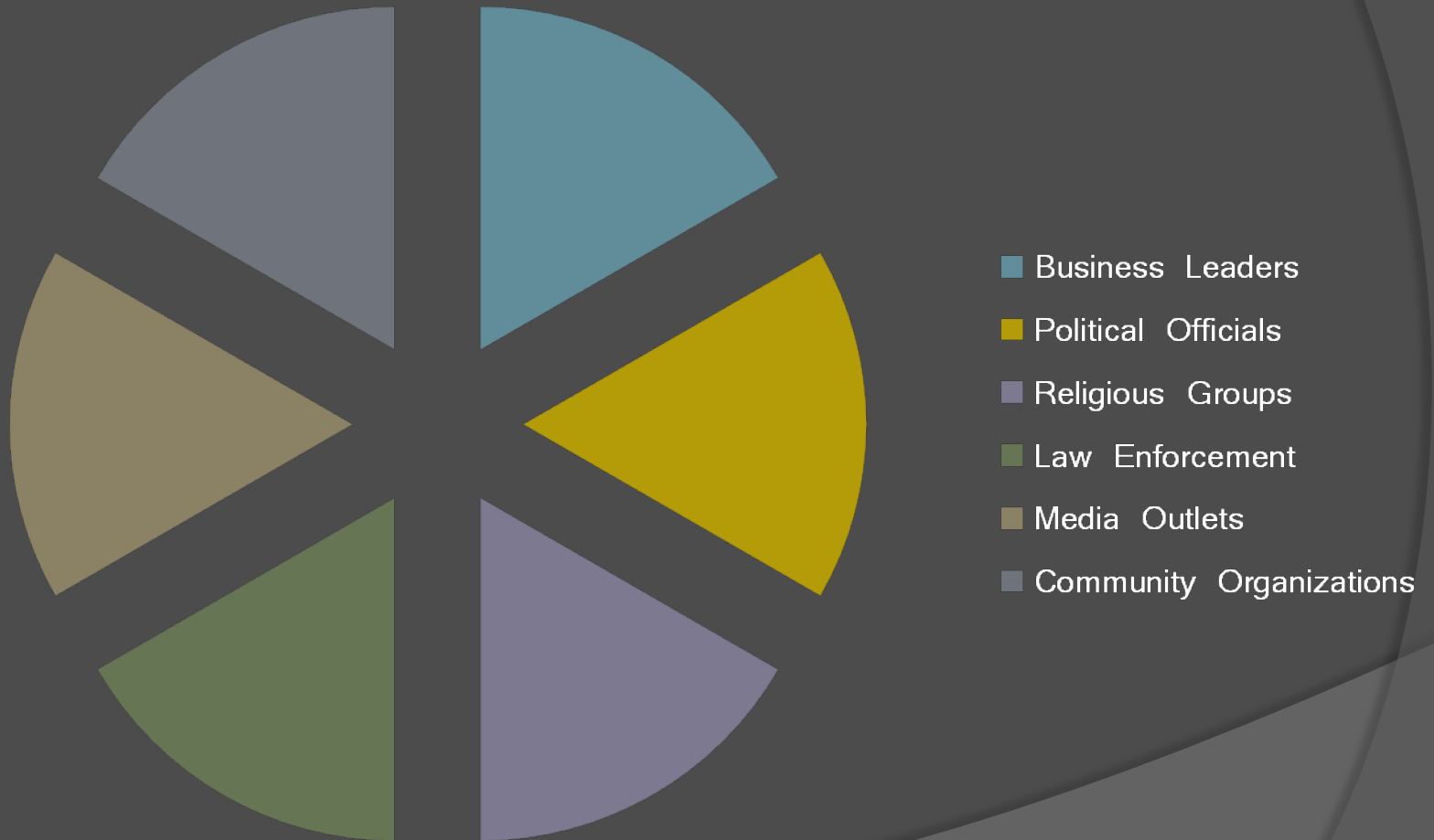


Illegal

Complex family dynamics and immigration patterns mean that some members of a family are in the U.S. legally and some are not. Police who focus on enforcement only immigration policies risk alienating entire communities who will not trust law enforcement to report serious crimes and may not be willing to serve as witnesses when crimes are committed. Many businesses rely on immigrant labor because U.S. workers will not work in jobs that are low wage and dangerous or unpleasant. There are many high skilled professionals who cannot remain in the country because of a broken visa system. Are we really willing to withhold emergency medical care from someone because of where they were born? Should we withhold education from children because of choices their parents made?

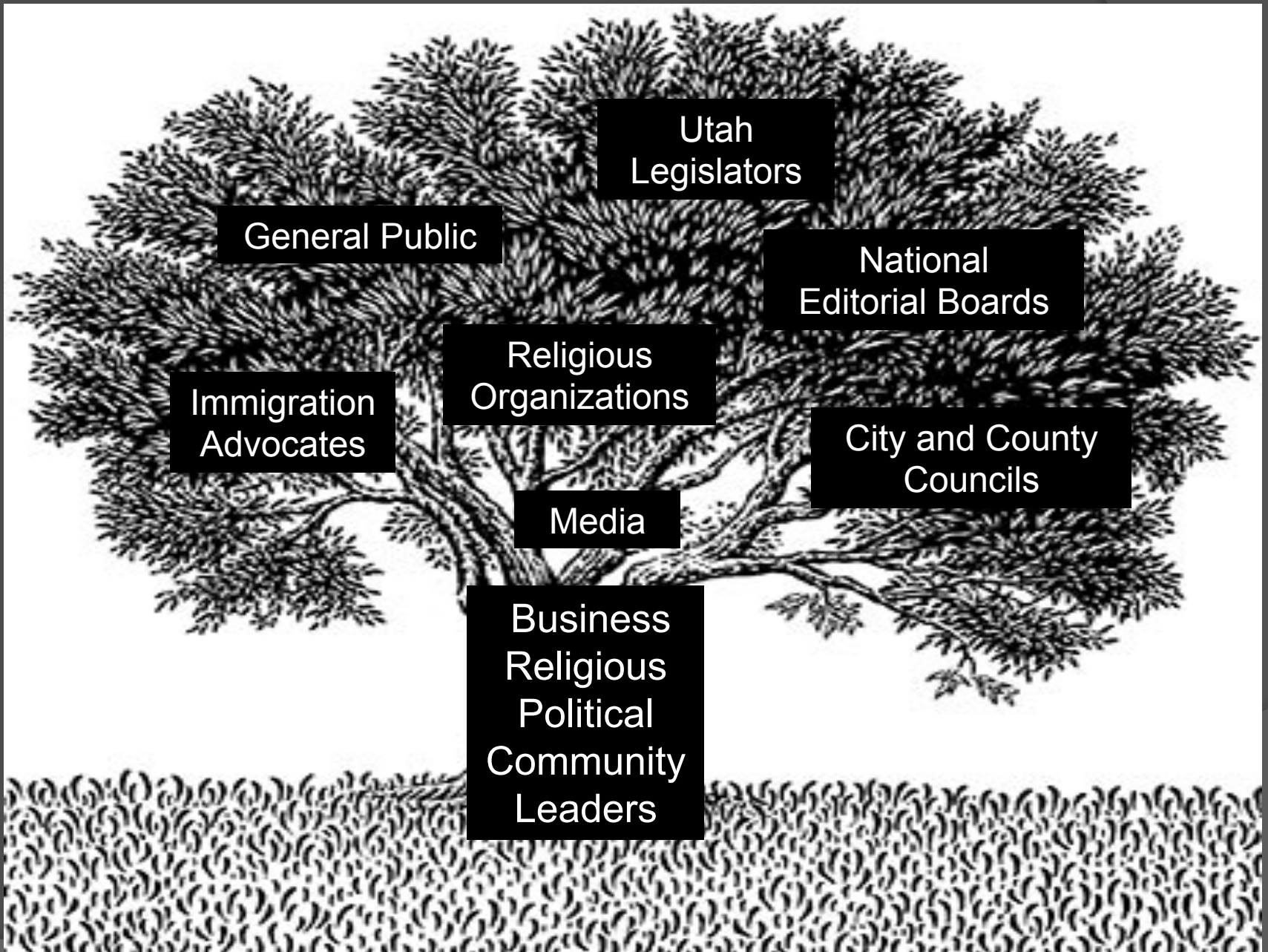

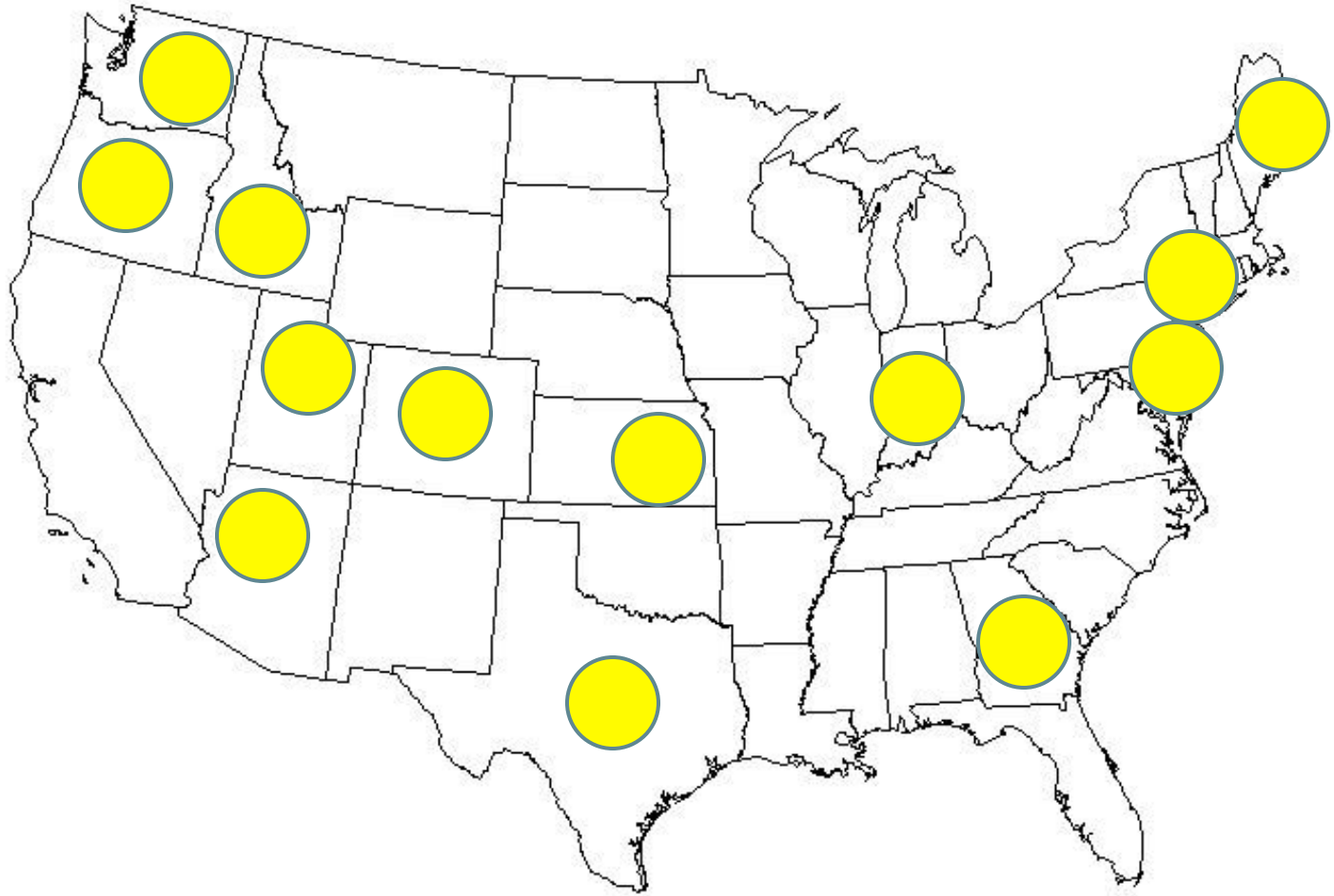
